"Rice Research in Ethiopia and Future Japan-Ethiopia Collaboration"

Purpose: Iwate University and the Ethiopian Institute of Agricultural Research (EIAR) signed a joint research agreement in 2022 to develop cold-tolerant and disease-resistant rice varieties through crossbreeding between "Hitomebore," a major cold-tolerant variety in the Tohoku region of Japan, and "X-Jigna," a major variety in the Fogera Plain in Ethiopia. Ethiopian researchers from Fogera National Rice Research and Training Center (FNRRTC) of EIAR participating in the joint research will visit Iwate from July 22 to August 1 to undergo training in rice breeding.

The seminar aims to introduce Ethiopia's rice development, JICA's technical cooperation, and the Iwate University – EIAR joint research, with the goal of promoting further collaboration between Japan and Ethiopia.
